6. PRESIDENT'S / STAFF REPORTS

PROJECT:

I.Prairie Robotics - Contamination Reduction Pilot

Mr. Aldridge expressed that as we are aware, SCRRRA is struggling with contamination in our curbside recycling program which measured over 26% in the audit performed by Casella. Trash residue represents the highest cost commodity a SCRRRA ton, Calculated at \$95 per ton. Mr. Aldridge believes that is we can significantly Reduce the level of contamination our negotiating position with Casella will be much improved when our current contract expires. Today, we have with us Reid Patterson of Prairie Robotics, a firm that has developed a contamination reduction program that utilizes artificial intelligence to identify offending residences and communicates with them to correct the error in separation. Mr. Patterson prepared a proposal for a pilot project in one of our towns to see is this technology can make a Significant improvement in our performance. The Executive Committee listened to this presentation and agreed to bring this to the full Board.

Joe Bragaw brought this topic up in the last Executive Committee meeting prompting Mr. Barger to research and provide this opinion. III. Draft Employee Handbook

Mr. Aldridge said that last week he distributed a draft copy of the SCRRRA Employee Handbook and Personnel Rules. This document was developed through a calibration with our HR Consultant, Paychex. It is in compliance with federal, state municipal labor law. Moving forward as laws change, we will be notified by Paychex to ensure that we are in compliance. This document incorporates our current Personnel Policy and will serve as its replacement. The document

Has been reviewed by our attorney and the Human Resource Committee before bringing it to you for a vote of acceptance. Mr. Aldridge said that he does not intend to ask for a vote today due to its length and complexity, but he intends to raise it for a vote in our February meeting.
