- ❌ Electronics
- ❌ Medical Waste
- ❌ Dryer Sheets

## Why Recycle?

## Items for the Transfer Station

Many items that cannot go in your curbside bin can be recycled at your local transfer station:

- ✓ Electronics
- ✓ Batteries
- ✓ Used Motor Oil & Oil Filters
- ✓ Used Antifreeze
- ✓ Used Cooking Oil
- ✓ Tires
- ✓ Leaves
- ✓ Brush
- ✓ Appliances

Paper (Not Shredded)

- ✓ No items smaller than 2" x 2"
- ✓ All items empty, clean, and dry
- ✓ Cardboard flattened
- ✓ No unacceptable items
